On the Sunday morning of the congress - as a rare treat - the world-renowned Jessica Pryce-Jones will present a special session on presentation skills for registrars. This session will be open to all delegates.

As post-congress event, on Monday 28 August 2017, there is a Multi-disciplinary Aesthetic Anatomy and Injectable Course available in Johannesburg. More information on this course is available on the SASDS website.

On behalf of the Vitiligo Society of South Africa (VSSA), it gives me great pleasure to invite you all to register as delegates for the combined congress of three great societies. This combined congress has earned an established place in the dermatological scene in South Africa.

It has been particularly rewarding working with the Dermatological Society of South Africa (DSSA) and the South African Society of Dermatological Surgery (SASDS) to ensure the success of the up-coming congress.
